

How does RxConnect work?

When you call RxConnect, a trained specialist will find the right drug manufacturer patient assistance programs to meet your income and prescription needs.

With the information you provide, the specialist will use a computer to fill out the applications. These will be sent to you. You will need to add the supporting paperwork and bring all the forms to your medical clinic. Your doctor will need to sign the applications before they are sent to the drug manufacturers. If everything is in order, the drug manufacturers will send a supply of drugs, most likely for three months, to your clinic for you to pick up.
